

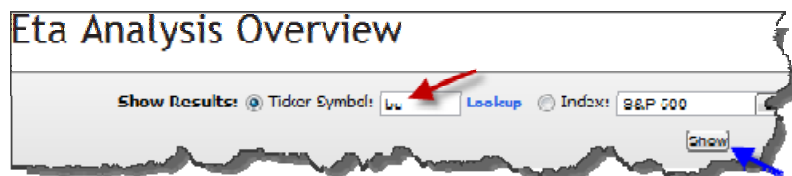
How Do I See the Basic Economic Profile of my Stock or Fund?

EconomicInvestor's Eta Analysis Overview, based on our exclusive patented processes, gives you basic information about how the economy impacts your stocks or funds.



To begin, click on the “Overview Report” option at the top of the “Online Research” menu.

This will take you to a screen where you can enter the ticker symbol (the one-to-five-letter code that identifies a company or fund, such as “BA” for Boeing Co) of the stock you’re interested in. (If you don’t know the ticker symbol of the stock or fund you are looking for, click on “Symbol Lookup” and type in the company name to find the ticker.)



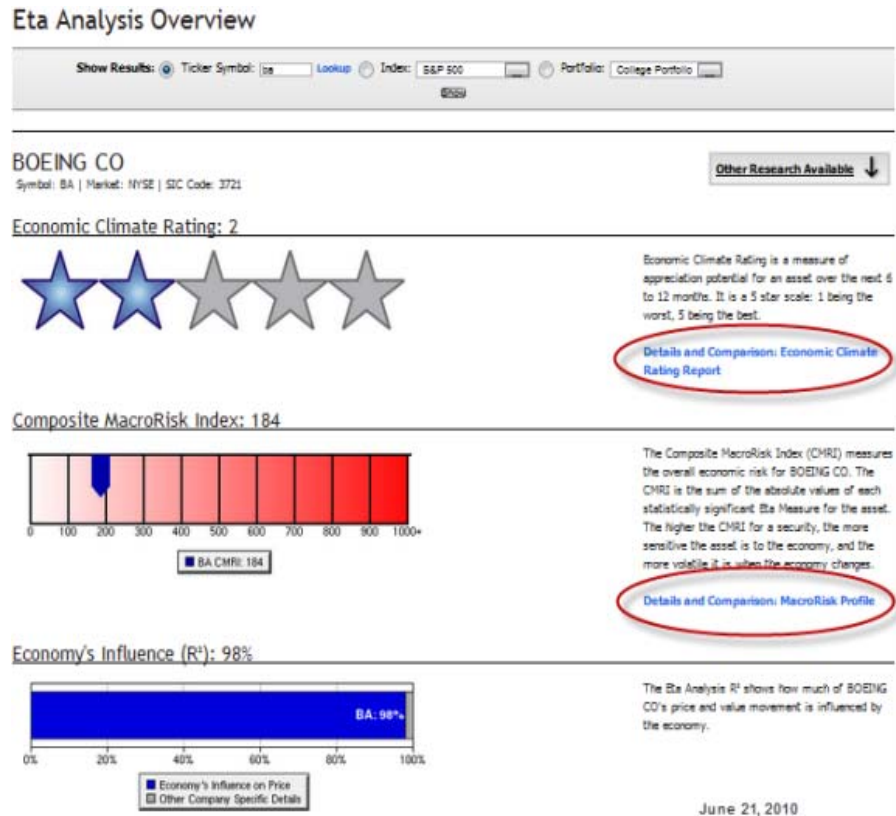
Finally, click “Get Report.”

This will take you to the Eta Analysis Overview screen for that stock or fund. This gives you a basic summary of the stock or fund’s economic information.

You can see:

- its **Climate Rating** (which shows whether the current economy is likely to help or hinder the stock/fund),
- its **Composite MacroRisk Index** (which shows how risky the economy suggests that your stock/fund is),
- and the **Economy’s Influence** on your stock (which shows how much of your stock’s/fund’s movement is generally caused by the economy, not by company-specific factors).



You can get more details about the economic climate rating or economic risk of the stock or fund by clicking the “Details and Comparison” buttons to the right of the summary information (circled in red above).
